

Off-Campus Programs Endowed Scholarship

Eligibility, Criteria, Procedures

Eligibility

- Student must be pursuing a bachelor's or master's degree through Central Michigan University's Off-Campus Programs.

Criteria

- Student must have regular admission to their degree program
- Undergraduate students must have completed a minimum of 12 CMU credit hours and have a GPA of 2.5
- Graduate students must have completed a minimum of 9 CMU graduate credit hours and have a GPA of 3.0
- Students who are unemployed at the time of application and students who are single parents are encouraged to apply for this scholarship

Procedures

- Student must file an official application form.
- Student must include a letter of recommendation from an instructor who has taught a course in the student's program.
- Student must provide a narrative description of personal and career objectives and how the CMU program will contribute to meeting these goals.
- Unemployed students must include a notarized statement to that effect.
- Applications due to Scholarship Committee by June 5, 2009.
- A scholarship committee appointed by the Vice President/Executive Director, Off-Campus Programs, will receive and review applications. The Vice President/Executive Director, in consultation with the financial aid office, will determine scholarship recipient(s).
- Official announcement of recipient(s): July 17, 2009.

Minimum requirements: Students must be pursuing a bachelor's or master's degree through the Central Michigan University's Off-Campus Programs.
