**DIRECTIONS TO THE BARDEN EDUCATION CENTER**  
**FORT BELVOIR**

Fort Belvoir is located on US Route 1 approximately 15 miles SW of DC and about 5 miles south of the Beltway intersection of I-95 and I-495.

**All non-DoD registered vehicles must enter through Tulley Gate. You can access the base daily by proceeding through the vehicle inspection line. Please have your driver's license, vehicle registration and car insurance paperwork available for inspection. Tulley Gate is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week.**

**Everyone must Exit Fort Belvoir through Tulley Gate after 9 p.m.**

**Non-DoD Registered Vehicles**

**Tulley Gate open 24 hours 7 days a week**

Tulley Gate entrance is at the intersection of Route 1 and **Pohick Road**. Pohick Road is not marked but opposite Pohick Road is Backlick Road. The intersection has an old strip mall on one corner and old hotel on the other. The gate is about one half mile into the post. The guard will direct non-DOD decal vehicles into the vehicle inspection area. The vehicle registration, insurance and photo ID are required.

Continue through the vehicle inspection area on **Pohick Road** to the third traffic light (Belvoir Road). The **Barden Education Center** is at the 1 o'clock position. Turn right onto Belvoir Road. Take the first left onto Langfitt; entrance to the parking lot is on the left. Enter through the center double doors.

**From the south:**

Take I-95 North to Route 1 exit at the Occoquan Bridge. Continue on Route 1 North past the intersection with 7100, Fairfax County parkway and take the next right **Tulley Gate** onto Fort Belvoir. The road is not marked, the intersection has old strip mall and old hotel.

**From Old Town Alexandria:**

Take the George Washington Parkway past Mount Vernon, the Estate. Mount Vernon Highway dead-ends into US Route 1. Turn left onto US Route 1 South. The second traffic light is Belvoir Road. DoD registered vehicles may enter through the Pence Gate, all vehicles others must continue to the next light, Backlick Road/Pohick Road, just south of the **Burger King** and turn left into **Tulley Gate**. You can take Route I the entire way from Old Town, be prepared for many stop lights.

**From the Springfield/Franconia Parkway:**

Take the Springfield/Franconia Parkway northeast past the Springfield Metro Station. At the first traffic light after the metro station, turn right onto Beulah. Follow Beulah for approximately 3 miles where it runs direction into Woodlawn Road. DoD decal vehicles may enter this gate. All other vehicles must turn right onto Telegraph Road. Continue on Telegraph Road approximately 2 miles to 7100 Fairfax County Parkway. Turn left onto 7100 Fairfax County Parkway East. 7100 ends at US Route 1. Turn left onto US Route 1 North, and take the next right into **Tulley Gate**.

**From the Beltway (I-95) east side:** Take the Beltway South over the Woodrow Wilson Bridge and take the Route 1, South Exit. Follow US Route 1 for approximately 7 miles. Turn left onto Backlick/Pohick Road to enter into **Tulley Gate**.

**From the north and Beltway (I-495) west side:** Take I-395 south and continue past Springfield on I-95 to 7100 East (Fairfax County Parkway) or on the Beltway take I-495 to I-95 south and proceed southbound until reaching 7100 East. 7100 dead-ends at US Rout 1. Turn left onto Route 1 North and take the next right into **Tulley Gate**.

## **DoD Registered Vehicles**

### **From the south:**

Take I-95 North exit at the Occoquan Bridge onto Route 1. Pass 7100, Fairfax County Parkway and turn at the next right (**Tulley Gate**) onto Fort Belvoir.

### **From Old Town Alexandria:**

Take the George Washington Parkway past Mount Vernon, the Estate. Mount Vernon Highway dead-ends into US Route 1. Turn left onto US Route 1 South. The second traffic light is Belvoir Road. DoD registered vehicles may enter through the **Pence Gate**, all others must continue to the next light, Backlick Road/Pohick Road. You must exit through Tulley gate after 9 p.m.

Stay on Belvoir Road until reaching the traffic light. The **Barden Education Center** is at this intersection at your 11 o'clock position. Proceed straight ahead past the building then turn left onto Langfitt. Entrance to the parking area is on the left. Enter through the center double doors.

### **From the Springfield/Franconia Parkway:**

Take the Springfield/Franconia Parkway northeast past the Springfield Metro Station. At the first traffic light after the metro station turn right onto Beulah. Follow Beulah for approximately 3 miles where it runs directly into the **Telegraph Gate**. DoD decal vehicles may enter this gate.

After entering the gate, continue past the golf courses to the first light. Turn left onto Kingman Road, at the next light turn right onto Gunston Road. Continue on Gunston Road approximately two miles to Pohick/Twelfth Street. Turn left. The **Barden Education Center** is at the intersection of Twelfth Street and Belvoir Road. Continue to the next light, turn right onto Belvoir Road, proceed past the building. Take the first left onto Langfitt. The parking entrance is on the left. Enter through the center double doors. You must exit through **Tulley Gate** after 9 p.m.

### **From the Beltway (I-95) east side:**

Take the Beltway South over the Woodrow Wilson Bridge and take the US Route 1 South exit. Follow US Route 1 south approximately 7 miles. Turn left into **Pence Gate**.

Stay on Belvoir Road until reaching the traffic light. The **Barden Education Center** is at this intersection at your 11 o'clock position. Proceed straight ahead past the building then turn left onto Langfitt. Entrance to the parking area is on the left. Enter through the center double doors. You must exit through **Tulley Gate** after 9 p.m.

### **From the north and Beltway (I-495) west side:**

Take I-395 south and continue past Springfield on I-95 to 7100 East (Fairfax County Parkway) or on the Beltway take I-495 to I-95 south and proceed southbound until reaching 7100 East. 7100 dead-ends at US Route 1. Turn left onto Route 1 North and take the next right into **Tulley Gate**.
