

Getting Started Checklist

CMU Online

Thank you for your application to CMU Online. You should receive your admission status in 2 – 3 weeks. The following is a list of steps you will need to take to enroll in classes at CMU.

- Apply to CMU and send in your application fee.
- Request one official transcript from each school you have attended and have it sent to:

- Receive your admission letter from CMU's Off-Campus Programs.
- Once you are admitted, set up your [Global ID and CMU e-mail account](#) or contact the CMU Help Desk at 800-950-1144, ext. *3662.
- Read the [CMU Off-Campus Bulletin](#).
- Complete the [online orientation](#).
- Receive a transfer credit evaluation in the mail from CMU.*
(Bachelor's degrees only, if applicable.)
- Contact an academic advisor to develop a program plan.*
 - Bachelor's degree students: Once you have received your transfer credit evaluation, contact your [Academic Advisor](#).
 - Graduate degree students: Call 866-774-1018, option #2 or contact your CMU Service Center.
- Download [term schedule](#) for registration dates and information.
- Register for classes during your registration period and order the appropriate books from [MBS](#).
- If you are taking an undergraduate class, you may need to [designate a proctor](#) to administer your exams.
- Access your class and read the syllabus by logging on to [Blackboard](#).
